According to multiple global and local industry reports, the demand for accountants continues to outpace supply. In Malaysia, the national target of producing 60,000 professional accountants by 2030 still faces significant challenges, especially in attracting and retaining young talent into the profession. Factors such as the perception of accounting as a traditional or rigid career path, the lure of techrelated jobs, and a lack of awareness about the global mobility and leadership opportunities a professional accountancy qualification offers have all contributed to this talent gap.

This shortage is not merely an academic concern—
it has real and lasting impacts on business
confidence, financial integrity, and national economic
resilience. Professional accountants are at the heart
of sound financial decision-making, corporate
governance, sustainability reporting, and risk
management. Without a robust pipeline of qualified
professionals, both private and public sectors are at risk
of poor accountability and missed economic opportunities.



To become an ICAEW Chartered Accountant you must complete 450 days of on-the-job training alongside the study elements of the ACA qualification.

To do so you will need to secure a training agreement with ICAEW Authorized Training Employer (ATE). The training agreement will outline the support you'll receive during training and will include details about tuition, study leave and mentoring.

As well as offering study leave, employers will usually pay for your tuition with a dedicated provider, and also pay for your exam and student registration fees. You'll need to complete the ACA qualification before you can apply to become a member of ICAEW.


